



Safe Assessment & Management of the Aggressive Patient Kalgoorlie, 1 July 2025

The Safe Assessment and Management of the Aggressive Patient (SAMAP) Workshop is an interactive 1 day program that has been designed to assist health professionals in the assessment and management of the aggressive patient. Facilitated by a team of emergency and mental health clinicians, this course aims to support rural and remote medical practitioners to expand their mental health emergency skills and knowledge.

The workshop objectives include:

- Structure approach to psychiatric & behavioural emergencies
- Diagnosing mental health, drug induced & medical causes of behavioural emergencies
- Pharmacological and non-pharmacological approaches to management
- Human factors & resource management in behavioural emergencies
- Appropriate disposition and region-specific escalation pathways for managing behavioural emergencies
- Simulated case based scenarios

Eligibility: Interprofessional, rural medical practitioners, emergency department doctors and nurses, and paramedics. Priority is given to those working in the local region.
